3. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to enhance your experience on our Website. Cookies are small data files stored on your device. We use cookies to collect information about your browsing activities, even if you do not register or log in.

a. Types of Cookies We Use

- **Essential Cookies:** Necessary for the Website to function properly.
- **Analytics Cookies:** Used to understand how users interact with the Website (e.g., PostHog).
- **Functional Cookies:** To remember your preferences and settings.

b. Managing Cookies

4. Third-Party Services

a. PostHog

You can create and log in to your account using Google or Apple credentials. By doing so, you authorize us to collect your basic profile information from these services. We do not receive your social media passwords.

c. Stripe

d. Clerk

We use Clerk for user authentication and account management. Clerk helps us securely manage your login credentials. For more details, see Clerk's Privacy Policy.

5. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell or rent your personal information to third parties. We may share your information with:

- **Service Providers:** Trusted third parties who assist us in operating the Website and providing services (e.g., PostHog, Stripe, Clerk).
- **Legal Obligations:** Authorities or legal entities when required by law or to protect our rights.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, your information may be transferred.
